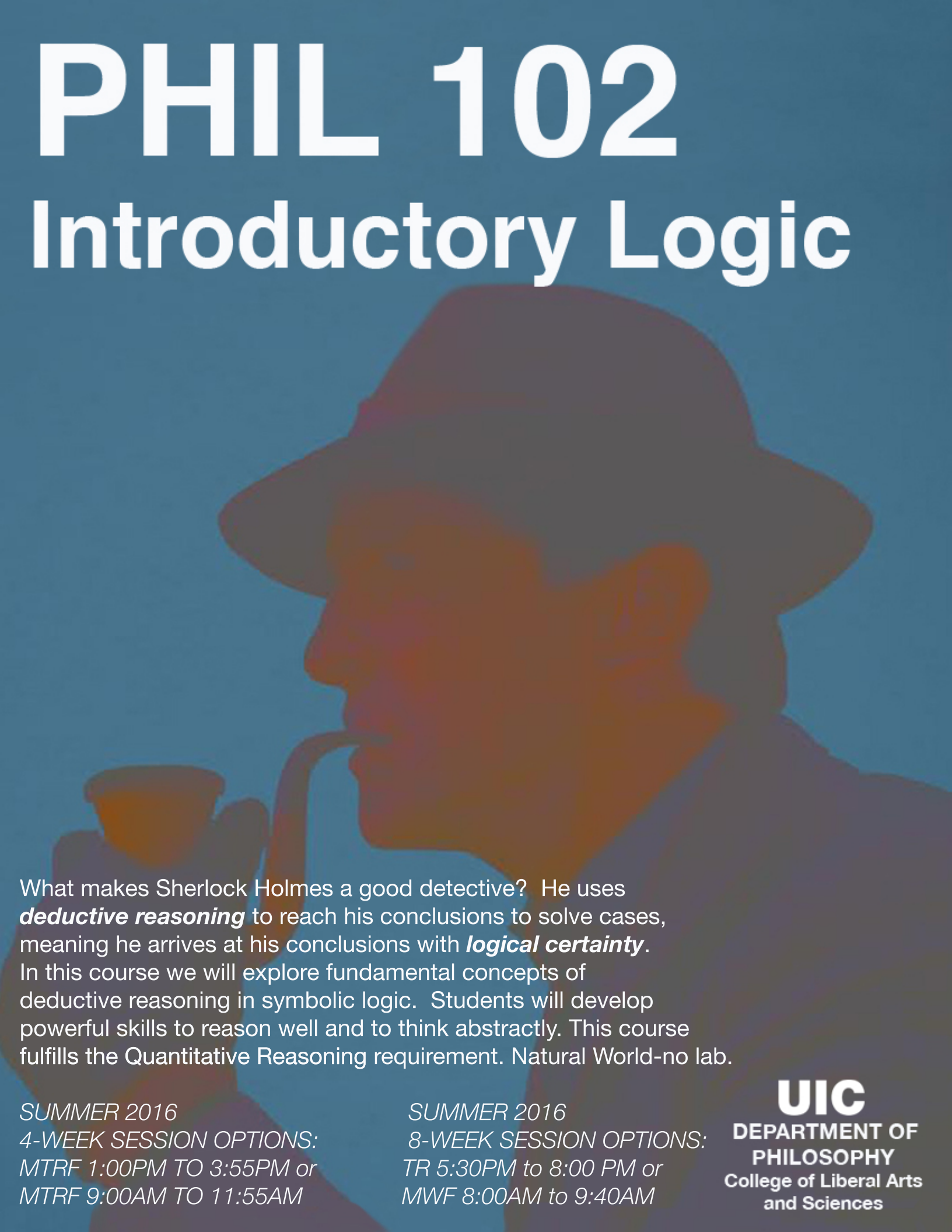


PHIL 102
